

Director Role Description

Beechville Lakeside Timberlea Running Club ("the Society")



The Society is led by a volunteer Board of Directors ("the Board") that is elected by members of the Society. Directors must also be members to be eligible for election. Officers, including the President, Vice President, Corporate Secretary and Treasurer, are selected from elected Directors by the Board.

Directors are accountable to members and are responsible for the management of the Society. This includes representing the interests of the organization and its members, acting reasonably and in good faith, placing the interest of the organization first ahead of furthering personal interests, acting within the scope of the law and following rules and regulations that apply to the Society.

Elected Directors are required to:

1. Commit to a 3-year term and have a duty to resign before the end of this term if something changes that prevents them from fulfilling their obligations.
2. Read and understand the bylaws of the organization.
3. Attend at least 2 board meetings per year plus AGM (face to face or through call in).
4. Commit to year-round regular attendance at club sanctioned group runs.
5. Complete first aid training required within 4 months of becoming a Director and renew training as required. The Board of Directors will have discretion to pay for training and will not require training if the Director already has received training through another provider that is current.
6. Be willing to communicate and make decisions through electronic means.
7. Be an ambassador and promote the club in any and all ways possible.
